 - State Preparedness Report and Regional Implementation Plan
 - Justin Cox with the City of Fort Worth is leading the UASI effort
 - Per Justin, not many changes that need to be made this year
 - We are one of the few COGs where the funding we receive has increased
 - Justin will meet with FEMA regarding the new online portal for submissions
 - They have added a core capability- suppression and environmental management
 - Next year, we will hire a vendor to update THIRA in the Spring
 - Once we establish what the resources are, we can plug them into the THIRA

- During project changes, if you have projects to include you will need to put a small amount of money in up front
- GDP IB 412 Refer us back to FEMA's information bulletins. There is a National Guidance that has come out for supplemental guidance for LETPA expenditures
- Big X Update
 - Brandi Lara with ReComm briefed on site locations, active teams, reporting time, etc.
 - The Big X regional full scale exercise is in November
 - The Big X exercise will be similar to the Urban Shield Full Scale exercise that we had in 2013
 - The exercise is over three days it will be full scale and functional
 - Brandi will get the Big X power point presentation out to everyone
 - Communications will do some assessments
 - The Big X coin has been designed
 - There will be social media to promote the Big X
